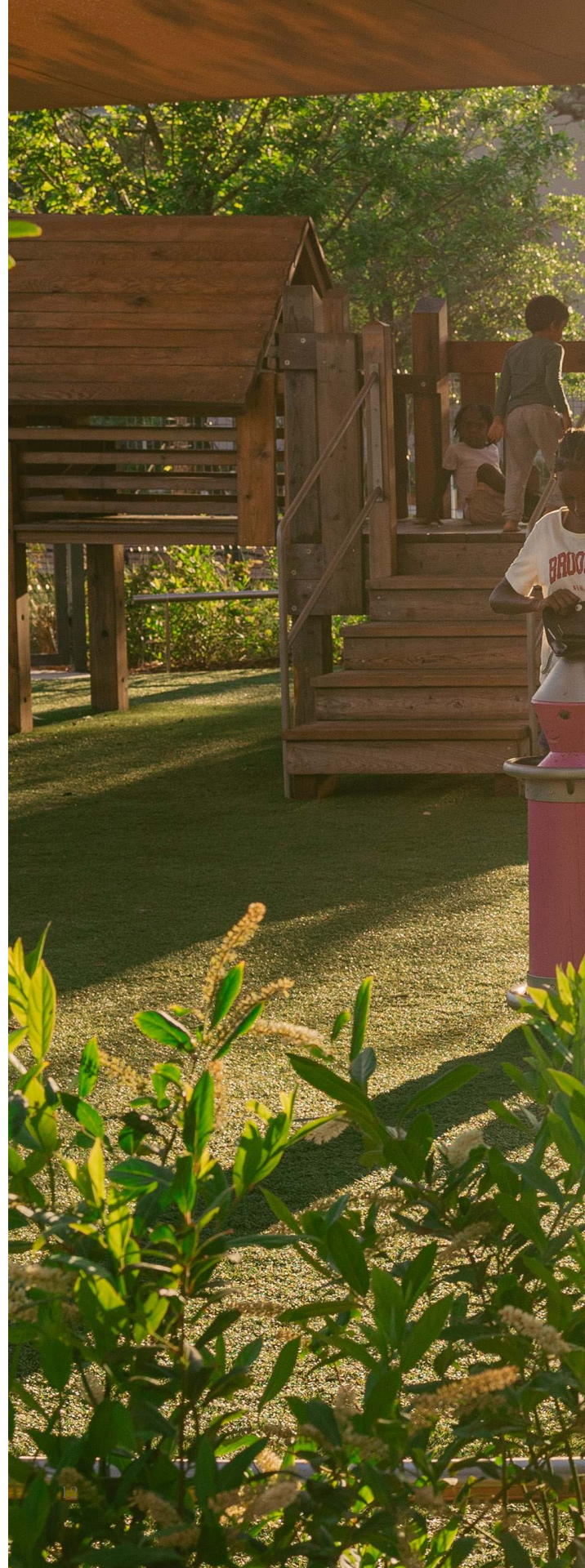

THE MISSION FIELD

The 10/40 Window spans North Africa, the Middle East and Asia, between 10- and 40-degrees north latitude. **An unreached people group** has little to no access to the gospel and a less than 2% evangelical Christian presence.

Millions of people will live and die without ever hearing the name of Jesus Christ.

The Opportunity

God's heart is for every nation, tribe, people and language to know Him, and He has chosen His church to carry the gospel to the ends of the earth.

85% of Muslims, Hindus and Buddhists do not personally know a Christian.

- + Thousands of languages still do not have a complete Bible translation.
- + The greatest concentration of unreached people groups is found throughout Asia and the Middle East.

Church Planting Vision

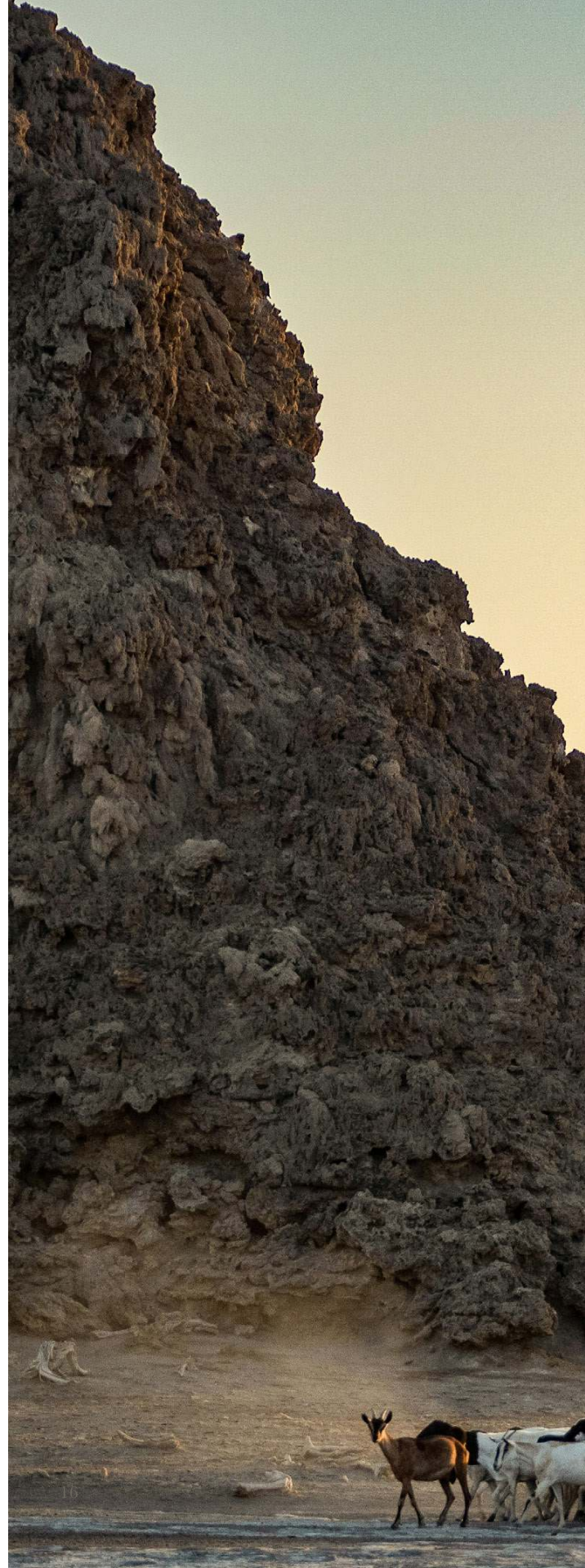
Neighbors to Nations exists to help bring the gospel to places where access is limited and churches are few. The local church remains God's primary strategy for reaching the nations.

INITIATIVE OVERVIEW

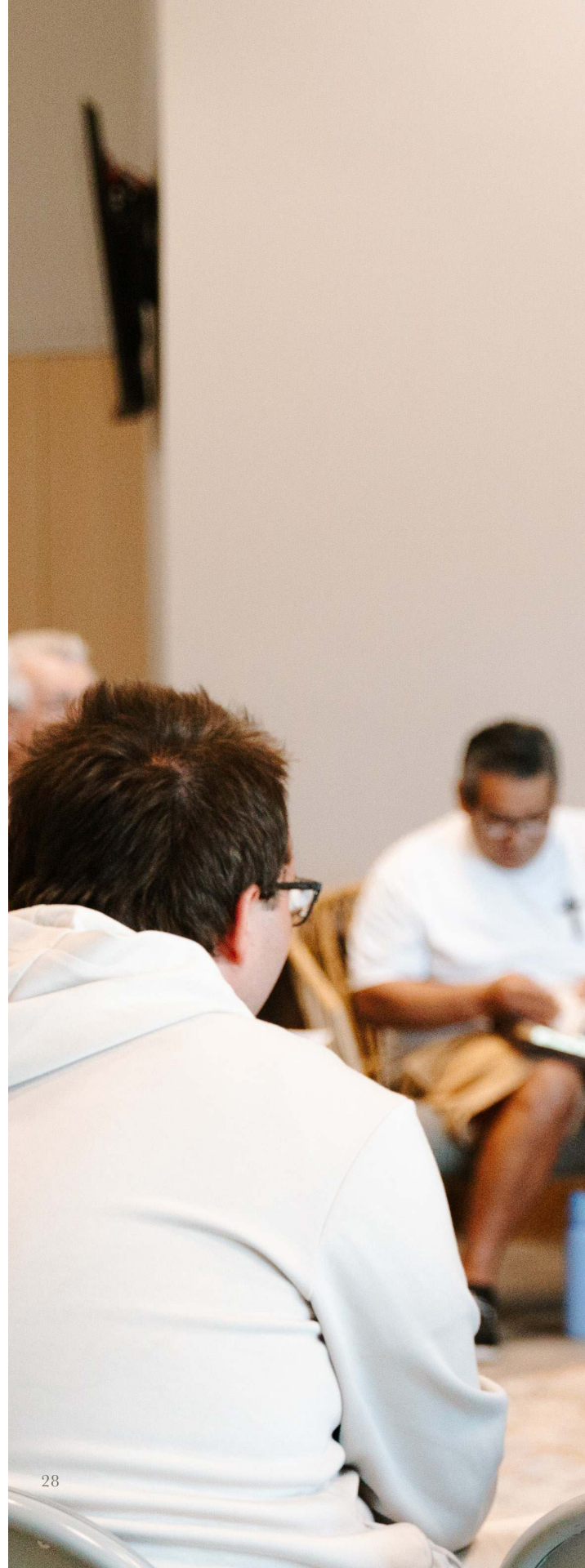
As we are on the go, we will take the gospel into our communities by caring for, loving and meeting people right where they are while pointing them to Jesus Christ.

WALK ON WATER

SCRIPTURE · MATTHEW 14:22-33

Where has God asked YOU to step out in faith?

THE PASSAGE

²² Immediately he made the disciples get into the boat and go before him to the other side, while he dismissed the crowds. ²³ And after he had dismissed the crowds, he went up on the mountain by himself to pray. When evening came, he was there alone, ²⁴ but the boat by this time was a long way from the land, beaten by the waves, for the wind was against them. ²⁵ And in the fourth watch of the night he came to them, walking on the sea. ²⁶ But when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were terrified, and said, “It is a ghost!” and they cried out in fear. ²⁷ But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, “Take heart; it is I. Do

not be afraid.” ²⁸ And Peter answered him, “Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water.” ²⁹ He said, “Come.” So Peter got out of the boat and walked on the water and came to Jesus. ³⁰ But when he saw the wind, he was afraid, and beginning to sink he cried out, “Lord, save me.” ³¹ Jesus immediately reached out his hand and took hold of him, saying to him, “O you of little faith, why did you doubt?” ³² And when they got into the boat, the wind ceased. ³³ And those in the boat worshiped him, saying, “Truly you are the Son of God.”

WEEK 4 · NOVEMBER 12/15

UPON THIS ROCK

SCRIPTURE · MATTHEW 16:13–28

The church is built on the gospel of Jesus Christ, and the gates of hell will not prevail against it.

THE PASSAGE

¹³ Now when Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, “Who do people say that the Son of Man is?” ¹⁴ And they said, “Some say John the Baptist, others say Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets.” ¹⁵ He said to them, “But who do you say that I am?” ¹⁶ Simon Peter replied, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.” ¹⁷ And Jesus answered him, “Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah! For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father who is in heaven. ¹⁸ And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. ¹⁹ I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.” ²⁰ Then he strictly charged the disciples to tell no one that he was the Christ. ²¹ From that time Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer many

things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and on the third day be raised. ²² And Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him, saying, “Far be it from you, Lord! This shall never happen to you.” ²³ But he turned and said to Peter, “Get behind me, Satan! You are a hindrance to me. For you are not setting your mind on the things of God, but on the things of man.” ²⁴ Then Jesus told his disciples, “If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me. ²⁵ For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. ²⁶ For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world and forfeits his soul? Or what shall a man give in return for his soul? ²⁷ For the Son of Man is going to come with his angels in the glory of his Father, and then he will repay each person according to what he has done. ²⁸ Truly, I say to you, there are some standing here who will not taste death until they see the Son of Man coming in his kingdom.”

SCRIPTURE · MATTHEW 25:14

14 “For it will be like a man going on a journey, who called his servants and entrusted to them his property.”

THE POINT
